

Crystal Goblet

Designed, folded, and drawn by Jim Turner



Start by dividing the paper vertically into 1/32s and also divide the top half. Start with the bottom-left crease pattern and then reverse fold the inner pleats upward and the outer pleats downward. This will result in the final crease pattern at the bottom-right. To lock the two sides of the paper together, simply fold the left-most and right-most pleats as one.

I recommend dry-folding the goblet with Wyndstone paper. After it is folded, put a small cup in the top to flare the top of the goblet and wrap the stem in fabric to keep it narrow. Then, place it in a humid place for a few hours. Once it dries, it should retain its shape.
